Ethics support at Stockholm University

- Established function at SU since 2017
- Support to researchers and leadership
- Advise from SU colleagues (legal experts, archivists, data managers) and ethics advisors at other universities
- Guidance based on legal obligations, “soft” guidelines and established principles as well as ethical deliberation

What we do

- Organise seminars and information meetings on e.g. ethical review
- Participate in meetings, seminars and courses held by departments
- Provide information on research ethics and research integrity on the web and in newsletters
- Answer questions from researchers

Questions from researchers

- Do I need to apply for ethical review and how do I write the application?
- How should I inform research subjects and ask for consent?
- How should I manage my data (including sensitive personal data)?
- Can I use data from other contexts (and if so how)?
- Who should be the author of a paper?
- How do I write an ethical self-assessment for funding applications?
- How do I report alleged research misconduct?
